



NABGG Scholarship Information

The National Association of Black Geologists and Geophysicists (NABGG) is honored to provide scholarships to undergraduate and graduate minority students enrolled full-time in geo-science programs at an accredited college or university. Scholarship candidates must demonstrate academic excellence, for the purpose of the scholarship is to prepare candidates to be the work force of the future. Funding for scholarships totaling over \$250,000 has been achieved through fund raising activities and corporate donations.

Scholarship Requirements

Recipients of a NABGG scholarship must meet the following:

- Be a United States Citizen or have appropriate Student Visa Card
- Majoring in the geosciences
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Submit a **complete** application package consisting of:
 1. a completed application form,
 2. a personal statement describing career goals, interests, honors/awards, and extracurricular activities,
 3. an official academic transcript, and
 4. two letters of recommendation (one from a Geoscience faculty member)

Selection Process

The Scholarship committee will review and rate all application packages received and make recommendations for scholarship awards. The amount of the award is determined by academic merit and is not automatically renewed. Applications need to be postmarked by **April 30th**. Award recipients will be notified electronically by **July 1st**; therefore, please keep NABGG informed with an up-to-date email address. The awards and a letter will be sent to the Department Chairperson on behalf of the recipients, so please include the Geosciences Department address. The awards will be mailed by September 1st. Recipients will be recognized at the annual conference and are encouraged to attend. NABGG is a non-discriminating organization. Any student meeting requirements are eligible to apply. **Incomplete packages will result in ineligibility.**
