CALL FOR NOMINATION FOR THE ELECTION OF NABGG SOCIETY OFFICERS: PRESIDENT ELECT, VICE PRESIDENT, TREASURER, ASSISTANT TREASURER, SECRETARY, ASSISTANT SECRETARY, AND PARLIAMENTARIAN

In accordance with the NABGG Constitution Article III, Section 2, the Nominations and Appointments Committee hereby solicit your nominations for the following positions:

PRESIDENT-ELECT (Term: January 1, 2012-December 31, 2013)

The President-Elect automatically succeeds to President for 2012-2013 and to Past President for 2014-2015; serves two years in each office. The President-Elect is a voting member of the Board and the Executive Committee. The President-Elect will organize long range planning and implementation of future activities. This individual will also act as liaison to the Board for all activities involving strategic and long-range planning activities.

VICE PRESIDENT (Term: January 1, 2012-December 31, 2013)

The Vice President is a voting member of the Board and the Executive Committee. The Vice President serves in the absence of the President. Preferred candidates are those who have served in some capacity in the organization before. The duties include coordination and management responsibilities with various organization committee activities.

TREASURER (Term: January 1, 2012-December 31, 2013)

The Treasurer is responsible for financial matters associated with the organization.

ASSISTANT TREASURER (Term: January 1, 2012-December 31, 2013)

The Assistant Treasurer is responsible for financial matters associated with the organization in the absence of the Treasurer.

SECRETARY (Term: January 1, 2012-December 31, 2013)

The Secretary is chiefly responsible for records, information, and communications.

ASSISTANT SECRETARY (Term: January 1, 2012-December 31, 2013)

The Assistant Secretary is chiefly responsible for records, information, and communications in the absence of the Secretary.

PARLIAMENTARIAN (Term: January 1, 2012-December 31, 2013)

The Parliamentarian presides over or advises the presiding officers on the implementation of parliamentary procedures at meetings and conferences.

NOMINATIONS WILL CLOSE ON FRIDAY, JULY 29, 2011, to facilitate the activities of the Nomination Committee prior to creation and distribution of the ballot. Ballots will be issued AUGUST 01, 2011 and the results will be announced at the annual conference business meeting in San Francisco, California.

FOR EACH CANDIDATE RECEIVING NOMINATIONS, the Nomination Committee shall obtain, in writing from the nominee, a statement confirming willingness to serve if elected. Individuals who so agree will be required to provide a brief biography.

Please be aware that in order for a nominee to move forward in the nomination stage, two nominations must be received for a single candidate. Individuals may self-nominate provided that two other appropriate nominators second the self-nomination.

NOTE: Nomination for Office is restricted to individuals who have active NABGG membership status and have previously served a meaningful role in the organization as a member or supporter.
